The Honorable Angela Fowler Takes the Oath of Office for
Commissioner of the Family Court of Delaware.

The Honorable Angela Fowler was sworn in for her first term as Commissioner of the Family Court of Delaware on Friday, April 11, 2014 at 3 p.m. in the historic Courtroom 1 of the Kent County Courthouse. The Honorable Chandlee Johnson Kuhn, Chief Judge of the Family Court, administered the oath of office, and Commissioner Fowler's family and friends led the pledge of allegiance and assisted with the robing.

Before her appointment, Commissioner Fowler served as a Hearing Officer for the Industrial Accident Board since 2009. Prior to that, she was a Deputy Child Advocate for the Office of the Child Advocate for eight years, and a Deputy Attorney General. Since 2001, Commissioner Fowler has held the position of Adjunct Professor for Wilmington University. For the past three years, she has also been an Adjunct Instructor at Delaware Technical and Community College.

Commissioner Fowler graduated *cum laude* from the University of Delaware in 1995 and from Widener School of Law in 1999. She served as a law clerk in the Sussex County Family Court after graduating from law school.

Commissioner Fowler is a lifelong resident of Kent County, and a graduate of Dover High School. She lives in Magnolia with her husband and two sons.
