ORDER

(1) On May 22, 2024, the Senior Court Clerk sent a letter directing the appellant to pay the Family Court filing fee on or before June 3, 2024, or this Court would issue a notice to show cause why the appeal should not be dismissed. On June 5, 2024, the Senior Court Clerk issued a notice, sent by certified mail, directing the appellant to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for the appellant's failure to pay the Family Court filing fee. The postal service later returned the notice as unclaimed and unable to forward. On June 26, 2024, the Chief Deputy Clerk reissued the notice to show cause by first-class mail.

(2) The appellant having failed to respond to the notice to show cause within the required ten-day period or to report any change of address to the Court, dismissal of this action is deemed to be unopposed.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, under Supreme Court Rules 3(b) and 29(b), that the appeal is DISMISSED.
