WHEREAS, the Superior Court has reviewed the requests by judges of this Court for "courtesy" copies to be submitted to chambers for ease of reference by judges and has concluded that these requests should be suspended until further notice.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, this 18th day of March, 2020, that this Standing Order No. 3 shall supplement Standing Order Nos. 1 and 2 and is effective 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, March 19, 2020, subject to further review:

- 1. In civil actions, Lawyers shall not submit paper copies or provide "courtesy" copies to chambers of any documents that have been electronically filed with the Court, unless a judge makes a specific request subsequent to this Standing Order for paper copies.
- 2. In criminal actions, Lawyers shall not submit additional paper copies or provide "courtesy" copies to chambers of any documents that have been conventionally filed with the Prothonotary, unless a judge makes a specific request subsequent to this Standing Order for paper copies.
