

Amendment of Supreme Court Rules 25, 29, 61 and 62

By an order dated September 22, 2025, the Delaware Supreme Court amended Supreme Court Rules 25, 29, 61, and 62. The amendments are effective immediately and are available on the [Court's website](#).

Rule 25(e), which addresses expedited scheduling, was amended to require a movant to include a proposed schedule with their motion to expedite and to indicate whether all of the parties agree on the proposed schedule. Rule 29(b), which governs notices to show cause, was amended to require responses to comply with the page and word counts in Rule 30. Rule 61, which addresses professional ethics, was not substantively changed. Rule 62, which governs the Board on Professional Responsibility, was amended to grant the Court discretion to appoint members to additional terms.
